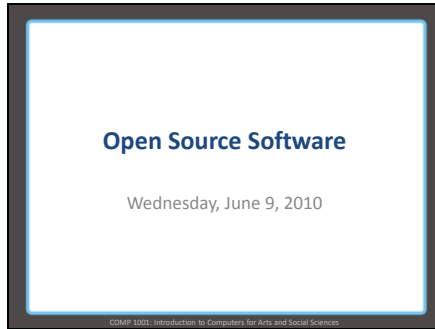

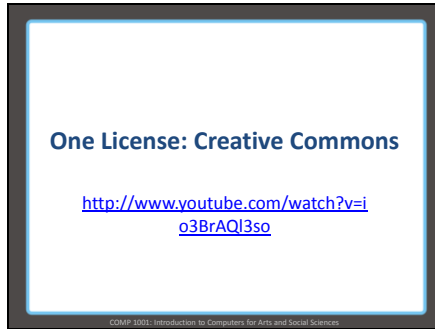

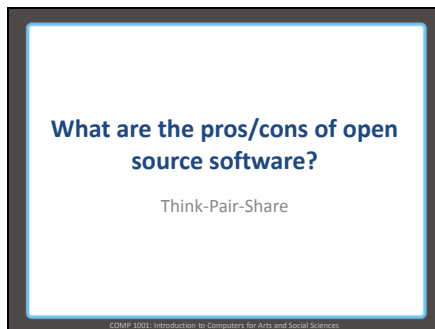
- Open source is all about freedom

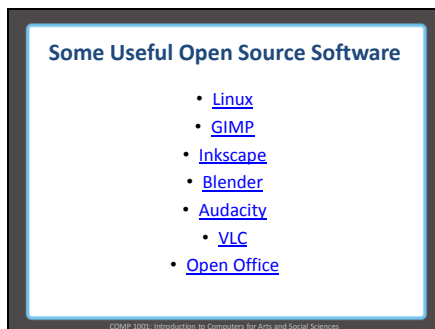
